Dormitory 3 Barbecue Space Usage Instructions

The Dormitory 3 Barbecue Space is a facility designed to promote interaction among students living in Dormitory 3 as well as those from other dormitories. On the other hand, Dormitory 3 is also a student dormitory where dorm residents live their daily lives. Therefore, when using the barbecue space, users must be aware that it is the living space of other residents, and must use it with moderation. Based on the above-mentioned purpose, these rules of use set forth the minimum rules for the use of the barbecue space.

1. Scope of users

The scope of users shall be as follows.

- ① Residents of Dormitory 1, Dormitory 2, Dormitory 3 and Ito Harmony House (hereinafter referred to as “Dormitory Residents”)
- ② Students, faculty and staff of the projects and intramural leading programs stipulated in Appendix 1, Article 2 of the Regulations Concerning the Center for Specific Large-Scale Education and Research Projects of Kyushu University
- ③ Students and faculty and staff of Kyushu University who participate in events organized by dormitory residents
- ④ Persons approved for use by the Student Dormitory Management and Operation Manager

2. Application for use

The person responsible for use must submit an application for use of the dormitory's common facilities, along with a list of names, to the Dormitory 3 manager's office at least two weeks in advance, and receive instructions from the dormitory manager regarding the use of the facility. Applications must be submitted in person; email or postal submissions are not accepted.

3. Hours of use

- ① The hours of use shall be from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- ② After use, clean up must be completed by 8:45 p.m. and confirmed by the dormitory manager.

4. Method of use

- ① Use paper dishes (paper plates and cups).
- ② Users must exercise due caution to prevent fire hazards.
- ③ Bonfires and fireworks are prohibited.
- ④ Each user must prepare garbage bags designated by Fukuoka City, separate and collect garbage, and take it to the collection point in Dormitory 3.
- ⑤ When extinguishing used charcoal, be sure to use an extinguisher pot to put out the fire, and do not leave it covered with water or bury it in the ground.
- ⑥ Before using the sink, leftover food on paper plates, grills, and tongs must be removed using disposable chopsticks etc. and disposed of as burnable waste.
- ⑦ Before washing, wipe off the sauce in the paper plate, oil on the griddle, and oil on the net and tongs using kitchen paper, etc. (Used kitchen paper must be disposed of as burnable waste.)

5. Alcohol Consumption

In principle, the consumption of alcohol is prohibited. However, this does not apply to university events, social gatherings, etc., where a faculty or staff member of Kyushu university is in charge and is present. (In such cases, prior consultation with and approval from the Student Support Division is required.)

6. Precautions

- ① Follow the instructions of the dormitory manager.
- ② As Dormitory 3 is also a living space for dormitory students, users must act with moderation and refrain from causing disturbances such as excessive noise.
- ③ If a user violates these rules and fails to heed the warnings of Kyushu University's faculty, staff (including the dormitory manager), the use of the facility will be immediately suspended. Furthermore, those involved will not be permitted to use the facility again.
- ④ In the event of damage to property in Dormitory 3 or the barbecue space, the user must pay for the damage.
